RESOLUTION NO. 2008-02**

**RESOLUTION DECLARING EQUIPMENT TO BE SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF
DISTRICT AND AUTHORIZING SALE**

Background: The Board of Commissioners presently owns the following described equipment:

1984 Ford F-700 dump truck VIN # 1FDNF70HXEVA02296 (estimated value over \$2,500)

The Board of Commissioners has determined that the above referenced property is not, and will not be needed for any District purposes.

The Board of Commissioners has determined that it would be in the best interest of the District to sell the listed equipment.

For those items with a value of more than \$2,500 RCW 57.08.015 requires that a notice of intention to sell shall be published once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the District. The notice shall describe the property and state the time and place at which it will be sold or offered for sale, and if at public sale the notice shall call for bids, fix the conditions of the bids and reserve the right to reject any and all bids for good cause.

Resolution: NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Midway Sewer District that the above listed equipment is surplus to the needs of the District and the Manager is directed to sell the equipment in accordance with the statutory requirements and in a commercially reasonable manner.
