NOTICE OF ULID PETITION

Your neighbors are taking the lead in bringing sewers to your neighborhood through a ULID process. To move forward with forming a ULID, property owners representing at least 51% of the total land area must sign a formal petition which is then certified to officially begin the process.

A petition for the formation of the ULID is being circulated by property owner(s) in your neighborhood. Signing the petition is a legally-binding agreement that you, as the property owner(s), are in support of ULID formation. Once the signatures are certified, a property owner may only withdraw from the petition before the Board of Commissioners' ULID formation hearing, which is held after certification. If more than 51% of the total land area remains in support, the ULID will move forward.
